Should a child, for whom English is an additional language, wish to join Hopelands School then their educational and welfare needs will be assessed by the Head or external agencies if necessary.

The cost of implementing these requirements, including assessments, CRB checks and resources will be passed to the parents and it will be their responsibility to pay all related fees prior to the child starting at the school.
