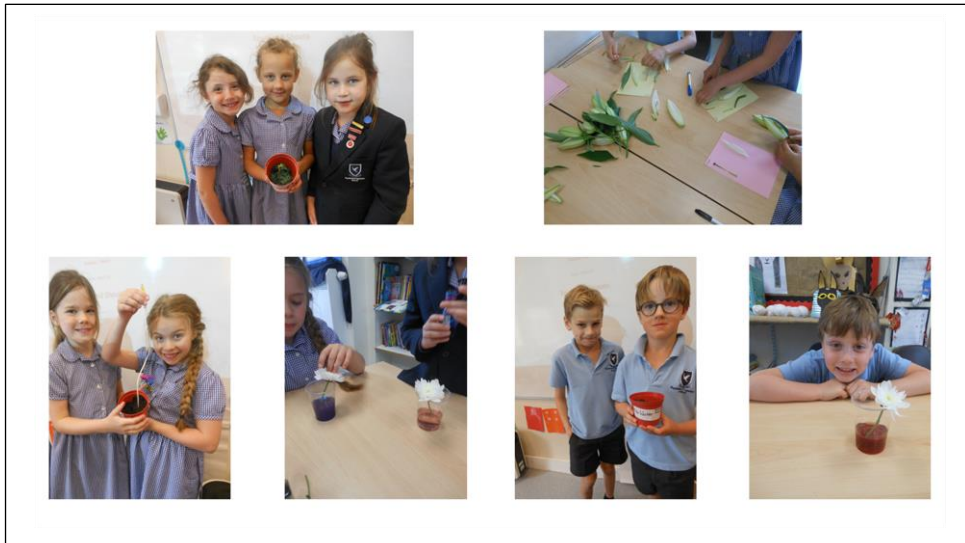

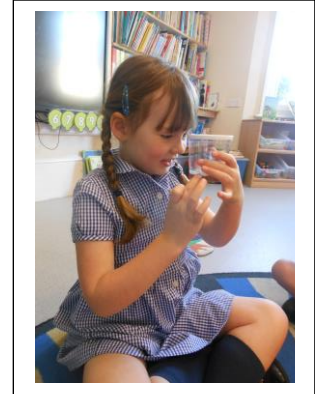
Pictures from the week
