

Please be aware that we don't have any seats booked on the left-hand side, as in previous years.

For those who have ordered ice creams, these will be delivered to me in boxes at the beginning of the interval. We will have a FOH team putting the ice creams into pre-labelled plastic bags for each family, and another FOH team distributing them.
