Tuesday 21st May,

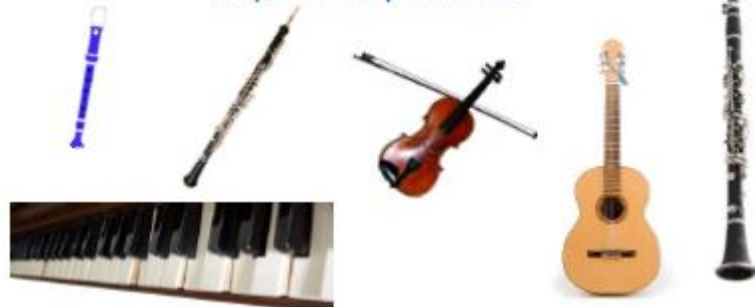
in the school Sophie Hall from 4 - 5.15 p.m.

Please come and listen to the children as it is their main opportunity in the year, to perform to an audience.

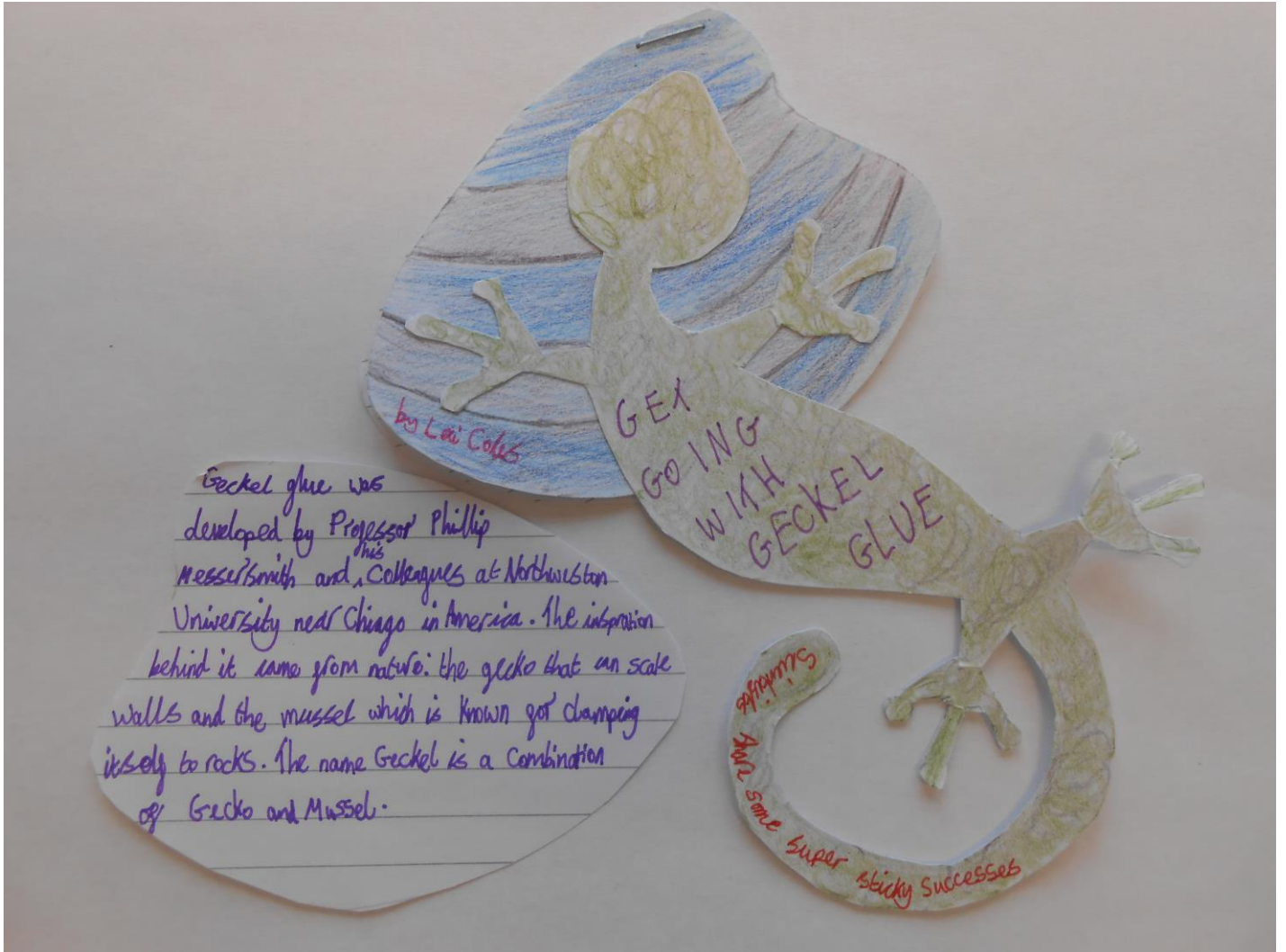
