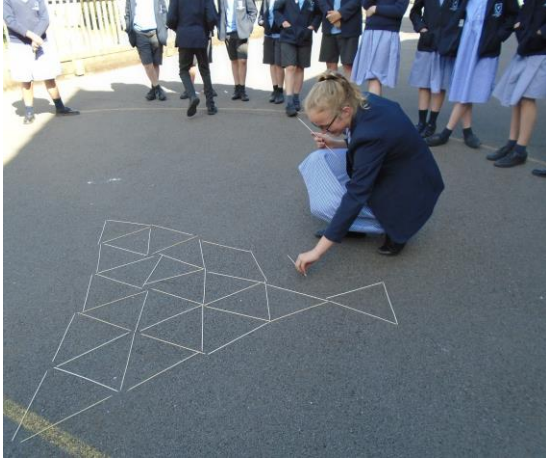
Music Concert
