Role Overview

We are seeking a part-time Caretaker to help maintain our school's buildings and grounds, ensuring they remain safe, clean, and well-kept. This interesting role offers variety and would suit someone with a good understanding of basic site maintenance and a passion for general repairs and DIY. The role involves manual handling, so candidates should be physically fit and capable of lifting and moving items as required.

Key Responsibilities

- Perform minor repairs, including mending windows, replacing light bulbs, and unblocking drains
- Operate heating and lighting systems, ensuring they are turned on/off at appropriate times.
- Maintain the school grounds, including litter removal and playground upkeep.
- Conduct minor plumbing tasks, such as fixing leaking pipes and repairing toilets.
- Carry out general DIY, including minor woodwork, and securely fix notice boards and other fittings to walls.
- Safely store and manage equipment and supplies.
- Ensure the school environment remains clean and safe for staff and pupils.
- Replace lighting tubes and lamps as necessary.
- Perform routine testing and record-keeping for emergency lighting and water systems.
- Adjust clocks and bells as required.

- Previous experience as a caretaker or in a similar role.
- A proactive and hands-on approach to maintenance and repairs.
- Ability to work independently as well as collaboratively within a team.
- Strong communication and organisational skills.
- Flexibility to manage a variety of tasks, including weekend checks.
