What an exciting time we had at the Tewkesbury Athletics Meeting on Tuesday – and I can't remember a time when so many parents were there to support us – as many as there were children taking part (making as much noise as the children and probably twice as nervous!)

This year two more events were added for the year 3and 4 children; throwing and standing long jump. 38 children from Hopelands took part, nervous, excited - and exhausted by the end of the successful warm evening.

Hopelands came 2nd in the field events and 3rd in the combined track and field.

A special thank you must go to Daniel Vaughan who ran in the Year 6 boys 1000m event even though he is only in Year 4. He volunteered to run *just so* Hopelands could score at least 1 point - but he did so much better than that; he came 3rd.

There were so many outstanding performances on the evening, from all age groups. A 13 year old school throwing record was broken this year by Oliver Attwater-Staite and he threw 47m on Tuesday (visualise half way along the 100m straight).AMAZING!!

The baton changing from the year 6 girls, which uses quite difficult theory and technique absolutely nailed the relays and the younger year 3 and 4 children, holding on to their nerves as tightly as the bean bag, remembered all the rules too and ran a great tactical race.

In all it was a great evening and I would like to send a massive thank you to all who made this possible.
