Morning and after school care

If you would like to use our morning and after school care provision, Mrs Coles (mornings and afternoons) and Miss Brown (afternoons) are here to look after your children. There's no need to book in advance for either mornings or afternoons.

In the mornings, you'll need to bring your children round to the back door of the hall where Mrs Coles will greet them. Morning school care starts at 7.45am and you can arrive at any time up until 8.30am, when the children are taken to line up.

On Tuesdays only, siblings of children going swimming may use morning school care free of charge **after 8.15am**.

In the afternoons, the children go to register at 3.30pm and are given biscuits. They play together and have a run around until 3.45pm when clubs and homework club are called. All children in yr3 and up go to homework club if they're not doing another club, and the younger children remain in after school care. Once the clubs are over, the children all return to after school care to play until they are collected.

After school provision ends at 5.30pm so please ensure your children are collected by this time. It is vitally important that you sign the after school register before taking your children off the premises please, so that all children are accounted for at all times.
